***Horse & Country Racehorses Championship at 2018 Ingliston Grand Slam – The Horse & Country Racehorses (HCR) series is open to Thoroughbreds who have raced, trained or been bred to race. Racing injuries will be ignored providing the horse is sound. Riders must be 14 years plus, ridden horses must be 4 years plus and veterans are 12 years plus. Judges will not ride and you will not be asked to gallop as a ride but may be asked to gallop in your individual show. Qualification cards are handed out to 1st to 4th places inclusive but MAY be passed down to 6th place if the higher placed horses have already qualified. In order to ride at the Championship at Ingliston Grand Slam 2018 the handler/rider AND horse must be registered with HCR, and cards must be carried into the ring for signing. Non Members may qualify upon receipt of a non Member Qualification card. Non Members must register handler/rider AND horse no later than 14 days after their Qualifying Show and before close of Ingliston Grand Slam entries.**

*NO CHILD AGED UNDER 3 YEARS ON SHOW DAY MAY COMPETE

*Numbers to be collected from the Secretary on the Show Day

*Riding Hats to standard BSI PAS015 1998, EN13841996, ASTM F1163, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS3838 1998, 2003, SAI GLOBAL must be worn at all times with the chinstrap fastened when mounted

*The Show organisers hold no responsibility for any accident occurring at this show.

*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes.

*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **AND MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS.**

*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30”).

*The Judge’s decision is final.

* An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

*An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced a horse/pony in the same year.

- *A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition during the current year.

*This Show is a qualifier for Equifest 2018 held at East of England Showground, Peterborough, August 2018. The first TWO competitors in “Equifest” qualifiers who have a “Equifest” card will qualify. The Judge or Show secretary needs to sign the qualification card to qualify. “Equifest” qualification cards are available free of charge from www.equifest.co.uk

*This show is a qualifier for the “15 plus” National Championship Show to be held at a venue to be decided in August 2018. The first 3 placed horses or ponies aged 15 years or over in each class will qualify for the National Championships. Further details www.15plus.org.uk Riders of horses aged 15 yrs and over to provide & wear red armbands

***TSR Showing Finals** - This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>
