NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This Show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2019.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details)

In each Class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify.

Winnings in the 2018/2019 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2019 Mountain & Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

***This Show Qualifier for TSR Showing Finals.**

Riders/Handlers can choose which Regional final they go to – Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, Wales South West, Scottish. All classes at this Show are TSR Qualifiers.

This Show is a TGCA Qualifier Affiliation No 19/0704/STD .

No known breeding required to enter these classes TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show “TOYS”. Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook). TGCA Qualification is awarded to the top three in each TGCA Class.

***This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground August 2019.** Equifest Qualifying Classes are in the Schedule below. Please ensure you have a Equifest Card with you for the Judge to sign. Cards available at equifest.org. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

*TSR Riders Champs – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the Ring.

*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes.

*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **STALLIONS MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS. (advised for NPS ponies)**

*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30”).

- *The Judge's decision is final.
- * An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.
- *An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced a horse/pony in the same year.

The three highest placed ponies which have not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify for the final at the NPS Spring Festival.
This Class is also a qualifier for **EQUIFEST Cavernoma Alliance Equifest UK M&M Lead Rein Pony.**
The first two ponies are eligible to qualify for Equifest. **£10**

First Ridden Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
First Ridden Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 11th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.
Please note that Equifest qualification applies to FR SP only. Equifest do not hold a First Ridden SHP Qualification that I can offer at the present time. £10

This Class is also a qualifier for **EQUIFEST The Jungle Hut M&M First Ridden Pony.** The first two ponies are eligible to qualify for Equifest. **£10**

36. KBIS / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year
