NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July – 2nd August 2020.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

Qualifiers for the NPS Spring Festival Winter Finals - In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2019/2020 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2020 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

#### **\*This Show Qualifier for TSR Showing Finals.**

Riders/Handlers can choose which Regional final they go to – Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, Wales South West, Scottish. All classes at this Show are TSR Qualifiers.

**\*This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground August 2020.** Equifest Qualifying Classes are in the Schedule below. Please ensure you have a Equifest Card with you for the Judge to sign. Cards available at [equifest.org](http://equifest.org). \*The Show organisers hold no responsibility for any accident occurring at this show.

\*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

\*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

\*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

\*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

\*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

\*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes.

\*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **STALLIONS MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS. (advised for NPS ponies) Mandatory for Stallions in ridden NPS Classes. Advisory for NPS In Hand Classes.**

\*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

\*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30").

\*The Judge's decision is final.

\* An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

\*An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced a horse/pony in the same year.

\*A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition during the current year.
