This year's Caledonian Showing Championships will be held at *Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife in October 2022*

Every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand & Ridden Showing classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.co.uk where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.

FOAL AND YOUNGSTOCK SECTION

Class 1. Weaned M&M/Unplaited 2021 Foal.

Class 2. Weaned Plaited 2021 Foal.

FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP, 1st and 2nd from Classes 1 and 2 eligible.

Class 3. Yearling, born 2020, any type/height.

Class 4. Two Year Old, born 2019, any type/height.

Class 5. Three Year Old, born 2018, any type/height.

YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP, 1st and 2nd from Classes 3, 4, 5 eligible.

Class 6. Plaited SP/SHP/coloured Lead Rein Pony. under 128 cm.

Rider not to have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 7. TINY TOTS Lead Rein Pony, plaited/M&M/coloured, under 122 cm,

Riders not to have attained their 6th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 8. TINY TOTS First Pony, M&M/plaited/traditional/coloured, under 122cms,

Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 9. M&M Lead Rein Pony. under 122 cm,

Rider not to have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 10. Home Produced **Plaited or M&M Lead Rein Pony.**

Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above Lead Rein Classes.

Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

Class 11. Plaited Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony/Coloured First Ridden Pony under 128cm.

Rider not to have attained 10th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 12. M&M First Ridden Pony. Rider not to have attained 12th b'day before 1st Jan in current yr.

Class 13. Home Produced **Plaited or M&M First Ridden Pony.**

Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above First Ridden Classes. Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP, CLASSES 6 to 13, 1st prize winners eligible.

Class 14. STARTER Ridden Novice Plaited Pony/Horse, not exc 148cm, Go round in Walk and Trot only, Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 15. Ridden Mxd Height Show Pony, not exc 148cm. Rider to be correct age for pony.

Class 16. Ridden Mxd Height Show Hunter Pony, not exc 153cm. Rider to be correct age for pony.

Class 17. Ridden Part Bred Plaited Pony not exc 153cm. Rider any age.

Class 18, sml/large HT/RT Intermediate not exc 158cm. Rider must be correct age for mount.

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 14 to 18, 1st prize winners eligible

Class 19. STARTER Ridden Novice Horse/Pony, Any Type, Go round in Walk and Trot only, Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 20. Ridden Veteran. Horses/Ponies aged 15 years & over. Any height/type.

Class 21. Ridden Critical Rare/Foreign/Heavy Horse Breeds. Open to Arab, Freisian, American Quarter Horse, Falabella, Fjord, Haflinger, Dales, Irish Draught, Cleveland Bay, Morgan, Hackney, Clydesdale, Shire, etc. Breed MUST be stated on entry under “notes”.

Class 22. Ridden Hunter, all weights.

Class 23. Ridden Riding Horse

Class 24. Ridden Hogged Cob

Class 25. Ridden Thoroughbred/Ex Racer/Been Race Trained

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 19 to 25, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

Class 26. Ridden Plaited Coloured Horse or Pony, Any Height.

Class 27. Ridden Native Coloured Cob

Class 28. Ridden Traditional Coloured Cob, Any Height.
(Please note Classes 27 and 28 will be run together with 2 sets of awards/rosettes)

Class 29. Ridden Hogged Coloured Cob, Any Height.

Class 30. Ridden Traditional Solid Colour Cob, Any Height, Full feather and mane & tail.
(Please note Classes 29 and 30 will be run together with 2 sets of awards/rosettes)

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 26 to 30, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

Class 31. STARTER Ridden Small Breeds M&M Pony, (Reg & Unreg Pony) Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 32. STARTER Ridden Large Breeds M&M Pony, (Reg & Unreg Pony) Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 33. Novice Ridden Small Breeds M&M, snaffles only. Registered ponies only.

Class 34. Novice Ridden Large Breeds M&M, snaffles only. Registered ponies only.

Class 35. Ridden Unregistered/Part Bred M&M, to be shown in natural state. Rider any age. Any suitable bit. Lead Rein ponies excluded.

Class 36. Amateur Ridden M&M. Registered M&M pony ridden & owned by any age of rider who doesn't receive income from Training, schooling or breaking ponies & doesn't receive income from giving riding lessons and/or training. Ponies can be Novice or Open and the rider doesn't have to be the same person. Rider can be unrelated to Pony's owner. NB. Both Rider and Owner need to be Amateurs as defined above. Any suitable bit. Registered ponies only.

Class 37. Junior Ridden M&M. Rider not to have attained 18th Birthday before 1st Jan in current yr.

Class 38. Open Ridden M&M. (may be split if entries warrant)

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 31 to 38, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

RULES

*All persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in the above show shall be considered as having read and accepted the following regulations.

*NO CHILD AGED UNDER 3 YEARS ON SHOW DAY MAY COMPETE

*Numbers to be collected from the Secretary on the Show Day

*Riding Hats to standard BSI PAS015 1998, EN13841996, ASTM F1163, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS3838 1998, 2003, SAI GLOBAL must be worn at all times with the chinstrap fastened when mounted

*The Show organisers hold no responsibility for any accident occurring at this show.

*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes and/or Veteran Classes and/or Junior Classes.

*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16 years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **STALLIONS MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS.**

*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30").

*The Judge's decision is final.

- * An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.
- *An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced a horse/pony in the same year.
- *A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition during the current year.
- *Competitors may be photographed for Sparket Equestrian Events Publicity in Newspapers, Magazines, Face Book and other media forms on Show Days. By taking part in any Sparket Equestrian Event competitors agree to being photographed for publicity purposes.
- *Horse Riding can be a dangerous activity. Nord Vue EC and/or Sparket Equestrian Events cannot be held responsible for libelous actions at his event by competitors or otherwise.
- *PLEASE NOTE NO LUNGING AT ANY TIME in car park or arena.
- *Anyone found to be misusing or abusing any person or animal (including horses) will be EVICTED from the premises IMMEDIATELY with no appeal.
- *The use of side or running or draw reins is forbidden at any time.
- *Please note that all Horses/Ponies at this event MUST be vaccinated for Equine Flu on a 12 month basis.
