Because this is a Championship Show feel free to dress up!! Ridden exhibitors may like to wear dark coloured jackets and stocks instead of their usual jackets and ties.



All Classes will be run in the same way as normal. There will be a “Go Round” and everyone will perform an individual Show. There will be SPARKLE finalist rosettes for all competitors, top two competitors in every Class will each receive a Class Sash, 1st to 6th placing rosettes, 3 award rosettes will be given out in each Class. Section Championship sashes will be awarded in addition to Supreme Championship sashes.

Three Special Award Rosettes as follows will be presented in EVERY Class!

9.00am START – Classes 1 to 8, Judge, Mr C Turner, Lancs.

Class 1. STARTER RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS M&M Pony, Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 2. STARTER RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS M&M Pony, Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.


1st and 2nd in Classes 1 and 2 are eligible to compete in the **STARTER RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP**, after Class 32 in the afternoon.

Class 3. NOVICE RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS M&M, snaffles only. Registered ponies only.

Class 4. NOVICE RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS M&M, snaffles only. Registered ponies only.

Class 5. AMATEUR RIDDEN M&M. Registered M&M pony ridden & owned by any age of rider who doesn't receive income from Training, schooling or breaking ponies & doesn't receive income from giving riding lessons and/or training. Ponies can be Novice or Open and the rider doesn't have to be the same person. Rider can be unrelated to Pony's owner. NB. Both Rider and Owner need to be Amateurs as defined above. Any suitable bit. Registered ponies only.

Class 6. JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A, B, C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.


 **Class 7. OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Small Breeds** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This is a STARS points Class.


 **Class 8. OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Large Breeds** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 yrs old & over. Rider any age. This is a STARS points Class
MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP, 1st & 2nd from Classes 3 to 8 eligible.

10. Best Turned Out


Open to any age rider, horse or pony. LR ponies eligible for this Class. To be judged as follows - 30% tack, 30% Pony/Horse, 30% rider, 10% overall impression. This is a STARS points Class.

 **11. RIDDEN SHOW PONIES (Mixed Height)** Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cm. Rider to be ANY AGE. This is a STARS points Class.

 **12. RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES (Mixed Height)** Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Rider to be ANY AGE. This is a STARS points Class.

13. OPEN RIDDEN PART BREDS Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 yrs old & over. Exhibits must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Riders any age.

14. OPEN YOUNG RIDERS exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to any type of horse- Hack, Hogged Cob, Traditional Cob, Riding Horse, Hunter or RoR. Horses will not be ridden by the Judge. **BTO/PLAITED CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 10 to 14, 1st & 2nd PRIZE WINNERS eligible.**

 **15. RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE/PONY aged 15 years to 19 years.** Open to horses and ponies of all types including Lead Rein. This is a STARS points Class.

 **16. RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE/PONY aged 20 years and over.** Open to horses and ponies of all types including Lead Rein. This is a STARS points Class.

18. LEAD REIN SHOW PONY/SHOW HUNTER PONY as below - To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

 **PLEASE NOTE ONE SET OF ROSETTES FOR THIS CLASS.** This is a STARS points Class.


A) Leading Rein Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

B) Lead Rein Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 10th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

19. HOME PRODUCED PLAITED or M&M LEAD REIN PONY.

Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above Lead Rein Classes.

Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

 **20. OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. This is a STARS points Class.

22. COMBINED FIRST RIDDEN SHOW PONY and FIRST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY. PLEASE NOTE ONE SET OF ROSETTES FOR THIS CLASS.

 A) First Ridden Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

B) First Ridden Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

This is a STARS points Class.

23. HOME PRODUCED PLAITED or M&M FIRST RIDDEN PONY. Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above First Ridden Classes. Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

 **24. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. This is a STARS points Class.

FIRST RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP, CLASSES 21 to 24, 1st & 2nd prize winners eligible.

27. RIDDEN HACKS, Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over over, exceeding 148cm, but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

28. OPEN RIDING HORSES, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height. Riders any age.

NB.. Classes 32 and 33 will be run together, but awarded seperately with 2 sets of rosettes/sashes.

 **29. RIDDEN PLAITED SHOW HORSE exc 148cm.** Riders any age. This is a STARS Points class.

 **30. TB/Ex RACER/BEEN IN TRAINING,** Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over, any height. This is a STARS points Class.

 **31. OPEN RIDDEN COBS,** Open Ridden Traditional/Hogged/Native Cob, Coloured or solid, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height.

EX RACER/PLAITED/COB CHAMPIONSHIP, 1st & 2nd Classes 26 to 31 eligible.

38. RIDDEN TRADITIONAL COLOURED Cob, Any height.

39. RIDDEN TRADITIONAL SOLID COLOURED Cob, Any height, Full feather and mane & tail.

 **40. RIDDEN NATIVE/TRAD/SOLID COLOURED** Horse/Pony. This is a STARS points class.

*Riding Hats to standard BSI PAS015 1998, EN13841996, ASTM F1163, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS3838 1998, 2003, SAI GLOBAL must be worn at all times with the chinstrap fastened when mounted

*The Show organisers hold no responsibility for any accident occurring at this show.

*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes.

*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **AND MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS.**

*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30").

*The Judge's decision is final.

* An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

*An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced/ridden/bought/sold a horse/pony for, or taken private lessons from in the same year.

*Competitors may be photographed for Sparket Equestrian Events Publicity in Newspapers, Magazines, Face Book and other media forms on Show Days. By taking part in any Sparket Equestrian Event competitors agree to being photographed for publicity purposes.

*Horse Riding can be a dangerous activity. Nord Vue EC and/or Sparket Equestrian Events cannot be held responsible for any actions at his event by competitors or otherwise.

*PLEASE NOTE NO LUNGING AT ANY TIME in car park or arena.
